Cross-country skis and snowshoe rentals are available from the Warming Shed on weekends only, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Children and adult sizes are available. Rental fee: \$10 (resident), \$15 (non-resident).

February 9: Visit Northwest Park from 12:30 PM to 4:00 PM for the 11th annual Cabin Fever Festival! Cabin Fever will kick-off with a large bonfire to warm everyone up. This wonderful winter event for the whole family will include demonstration by the CT Valley Siberian Husky Club, real pelts and skulls for you to see up close, and a live bird of prey show, all while we learn about our wildlife and how they adapt to the cold. The winter fun continues with contests, games and prizes. Refreshments will be sold.

Children age 2 and under are Free. \$3.00 per person (Windsor residents), \$5.00 per person (non-residents).

February 19: Come out to Northwest Park for a guided Full Moon Hike from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM. This moon is known by Native American tribes as the "Full Snow Moon" because the heaviest snow usually fell during this time of year. If snow conditions permit, bring your own snowshoes or borrow ours. Fee for this program is \$10 person (Windsor resident) \$15 per person (non-residents).
